Mission Trip Participation Agreement

Congratulations! You are joining CCC Youth Mission's growing family of missionaries. For the 2012 Mission Trips, we are asking you to make some substantial commitments to our team preparation. This form fully explains our expectations, restrictions and limitations for members of the team. Please read this carefully and review it with your parents/teens. Each expectation must be initialed by a parent and the student to indicate that you have read and understand what is required. Once you have initialed the individual parts of this form, a parent and the student missionary must sign at the bottom and return this form.

EXPECTATIONS AND REQUIREMENTS FOR PARTICIPATION IN CCC YOUTH MISSIONS TO AUGUSTA, GA

_____ The total per person cost for the mission trip is \$500 and includes all lodging, transportation, meals, and recreational events. This cost may vary due to prior mission trips. **You will have to pay in full your prior trip first, and then continue to raise money for your current trip.**

_____ The remaining balance will be paid as your funds become available.

****All payments are non-refundable****

_____ CCC Youth Missions will sponsor fundraising events and expects assistance in organizing these events from parents and students. Those who participate in planned events will receive credit that will diminish the amount of payments due as listed above. There are no guarantees made that fundraising will substantially reduce a missionary's personal costs. However, should your participation in fundraising exceed your needs, the additional money raised will go into a Missions Fund. Every attempt will be made to diminish the amount due at each payment deadline through fundraising. **Any funds raised after payments are made and in excess of what is needed cannot be rebated to missionaries.** We encourage missionaries to participate in fundraisers before each deadline.

_____ We expect those who register for the Mission Trip to actively engage with the team beyond the circle of friends they may already have on the team. To this end, we encourage groups of friends who are registered for the Mission Trip to intentionally work to meet new people. We will adjust dorm and hotel rooming assignments so that every participant has the opportunity to find positive connections within the team.

_____ The Mission Team is a Christian missionary team representing Jesus Christ and CCC. Members of the team are expected to dress modestly and respectfully, as they would for any church outing. This mission trip experience is to serve as a witness of our Christian faith.

_____ We expect our teens to be young adults. Misconduct will result in consequences ranging from a verbal reprimand to being placed in the constant company and supervision of an adult, to a trip home at parent's expense.

We have read, and agree to abide by, the expectations and requirements listed above, according to God's will. We pray that this mission trip experience will strengthen all participants' relationships with the Lord.
